Abstract: Prohibits the administration of vaccines on school property and at schoolsponsored events.

<u>Present law</u> requires each person entering any school (both public and nonpublic, from daycare through college) for the first time to present satisfactory evidence of immunity to or immunization against vaccine-preventable diseases according to a schedule approved by the office of public health or to present evidence of an immunization program in progress. Exempts students from this requirement upon written dissent or upon a doctor's note relative to medical contraindication.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits the administration of vaccines on school property and at school-sponsored events.
