**Abstract:** Provides for additional pay for P.O.S.T. certified sergeants-at-arms employed by either the House of Representatives or the Senate.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 40:2405) provides for peace officer training requirements.

<u>Proposed law provides</u> that any sergeant-at-arms of the House or Senate who is a full-time employee, who is paid a salary of not less than \$800 per month, who has completed and passed a P.O.S.T.-certified training program as provided in <u>present law</u>, and who has completed or who hereafter completes one year of service shall be paid by the state extra compensation in the amount of \$500 per month.
