**Abstract:** Prohibits arbitrary, capricious, or unreasonable discrimination based on a person's vaccination status or immunity status.

<u>Present constitution</u> provides that no law shall arbitrarily, capriciously, or unreasonably discriminate against a person because of birth, age, sex, culture, physical condition, or political ideas or affiliations.

<u>Present constitution</u> further provides that in access to public areas, accommodations, and facilities, every person shall be free from arbitrary, capricious, or unreasonable discrimination based on age, sex, or physical condition

<u>Proposed constitution</u> maintains <u>present constitution</u> and provides that physical condition includes a person's vaccination status or immunity status.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held Nov. 8, 2022.
