1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 49:954(C), relative to the Administrative Procedure Act; to provide for  
3 expiration of agency rules; and to provide for related matters.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. R.S. 49:954(C) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

6 §954. Filing; taking effect of rules; expiration of rules

7 \* \* \*

8 C. A rule adopted in accordance with R.S. 49:953 shall expire on June  
9 thirtieth of the year following the year of its adoption unless legislation is enacted  
10 to continue the effectiveness of the rule to a certain date or indefinitely.

**Abstract:** Provides for expiration of agency rules.

Present law provides that each rule adopted shall be effective upon its publication in the La. Register.

Proposed law retains present law and provides that a rule adopted in accordance with nonemergency procedures shall expire on June 30th of the year following the year of its adoption unless legislation is enacted to continue such rule to a certain date or indefinitely.
