Abstract: Provides for a civil judgment in favor of the victim for outstanding restitution amounts at the termination of a defendant's term of supervision.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the termination of a defendant's probation or suspended sentence in both felony or misdemeanor cases.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and provides that at the termination of a defendant's term of supervision, the court shall render a judgment against the defendant and in favor of the victim for any outstanding restitution.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the judgment can be pursued through executory proceedings in the Code of Civil Procedure.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
