**Abstract:** Provides strict liability for a person who sells, distributes, or delivers safety equipment and tools that fail to meet federal standards.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that any person who sells, distributes, or delivers any safety equipment or tools within this state that does not meet or exceed the safety standards prescribed by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) shall be liable for any damage or injury resulting from the use of such safety equipment or tools.

<u>Proposed law</u> applies to safety equipment and tools used in the commercial construction or maintenance industry and provided for in OSHA standards.
