Abstract: Prohibits state content standards and curriculum, content, methodology, and textbooks that limit or restrict the teaching of African American history.

<u>Present law</u> requires the State Bd. of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) to develop state content standards for required subjects. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but prohibits BESE from approving standards that limit or restrict the teaching of African American history.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes public school governing authorities to develop and implement curriculum, content, and methodology other than curriculum, content, and methodology recommended by the state Dept. of Education or BESE. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but prohibits public school governing authorities from using any curriculum, content, or methodology that limits or restricts the teaching of African American history.

<u>Present law</u> grants public school governing authorities the authority to adopt textbooks and other instructional materials. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but prohibits public school governing authorities from adopting textbooks or instructional materials that limit or restrict the teaching of African American history.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes any person to commence a suit in the district court for the parish in which an action in violation of proposed law occurred for the issuance of a writ of mandamus or injunctive or declaratory relief to require compliance with proposed law together with reasonable attorney fees and costs.

<u>Proposed law</u> is applicable to all public schools, including charter schools.
