**Abstract:** Adds certain substances to Schedules I, II, and IV of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the designation of controlled dangerous substances into Schedules I, II, III, IV, and V based upon the substances' potential for addiction and abuse.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds 24 additional substances to Schedule I and Serdexmethylphenidate to Schedule IV.

Proposed law adds samidorphan as a Schedule II substance of vegetable origin.

(Amends R.S. 40:964(Schedule II)(A)(1)(intro. para.); Adds R.S. 40:964(Schedule I)(A)(80)-(99), (C)(66), (E)(12), and (F)(29), and (Schedule IV)(D)(15))

## Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Administration of Criminal</u> Justice to the original bill:

- 1. Add the chemical names to the proposed law substances listed in Schedule I.
- 2. Remove seven proposed law substances from Schedule I.
