**SENATE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS**

2022 Regular Session

Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Retirement to Original Senate Bill No. 10  
by Senator Morris

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 3, after "Louisiana;" delete the remainder of the line and delete line 4 and  
3 insert "to provide for membership; to"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, delete lines 10 through 17 and delete page 2 and on page 3, delete lines 1 through  
6 13 and insert:

7 " **A. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any active contributing**  
8 **participant in the optional retirement plan on May 1, 2022, may make an irrevocable**  
9 **election to become a member of the regular retirement plan of the Teachers'**  
10 **Retirement System of Louisiana. The election shall be made in writing in a manner**  
11 **prescribed by the system and received by the system on or before December 30, 2022.**

12 **B. All contributions to the optional retirement plan from a participant making**  
13 **the election and his employer shall cease on January 31, 2023. Beginning February 1,**  
14 **2023, a participant who made the election shall begin contributing to and accruing**  
15 **benefits in the regular retirement plan of the Teachers' Retirement System of**  
16 **Louisiana as a member first eligible for membership in a state system on that date. The**  
17 **person's employing agency shall pay the system the contributions required pursuant**  
18 **to R.S. 11:102.**

19 **C. Any and all distributions from the optional retirement plan to a participant**  
20 **who made the election provided for in this Section shall be in accordance with R.S.**  
21 **11:929."**

22 AMENDMENT NO. 3

23 On page 3, line 14, change "Section 3" to "Section 2"

24 AMENDMENT NO. 4

25 On page 3, line 17, change "Section 4" to "Section 3"
