
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Administration of Criminal Justice to
Original House Bill No. 52 by Representative Hollis

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 3, after "penalties;" and before "and" insert "to provide for a presumption of
3 reasonable expectation of privacy;"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, at the beginning of line 8, change "A" to "A.(1)"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 1, line 9, after "device" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 10 through
8 13 in their entirety and insert the following:

9 "by a person with the intent by person to harass, intimidate, or cause
10 emotional distress by using the camera or other recording device to observe,
11 photograph, videotape, or otherwise record another person's backyard without the
12 consent of that person who has a reasonable expectation of privacy.

13 (2) If the backyard of a residential property is surrounded by fencing,
14 enclosure, or other barrier erected for the purpose of obstructing the view from a
15 public or private roadway or walkway or from another residential property, then a
16 reasonable expectation of privacy shall be presumed for any person who is within the
17 fencing, enclosure, or other barrier surrounding the backyard."
