Page 1 of 1 Constitutional amendment to allow the attorney general to institute, prosecute, or intervene in any criminal action or proceeding concerning a felony election offense. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))

Proposed constitutional amendment provides the Attorney General (AG) the authority to institute, prosecute, or intervene in any criminal action or proceeding concerning a felony election offense. The proposed amendment shall be on the ballot at the statewide election held on November 8, 2022.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. The Attorney General's office reports that any intervention in criminal actions or proceeding concerning a felony election offense can be absorbed by their current workforce.

The Secretary of State may incur minimal ballot printing costs associated with this measure. As a regular practice, the Secretary of State typically budgets for up to 10 constitutional amendments and statewide propositions for the fall statewide elections. To the extent the ballot includes more than 10 constitutional amendments and statewide propositions, the Secretary of State may require additional SGF resources for the November 8, 2022, statewide election. Any expenditure impact would be realized in FY 23.
