**Abstract:** Makes certain guidelines apply to pre-season and regular season practices and makes football jamborees and regular season games exempt from certain guidelines.

<u>Present law</u> states that pre-season games, such as scrimmages and jamborees, shall be subject to the modified guidelines of the American College of Sports Medicine and the National Athletic Trainers' Association regarding the heat acclimatization and wet bulb globe temperature policy.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes <u>present law</u> by adding that the provisions of <u>present law</u> also apply to regular season practices. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that football jamborees and regular season games are exempt from present law.

<u>Proposed law</u> defines "interstate game", "intrastate game", "jamboree", and "regular season game".

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

- 1. Exempt football jamborees and regular season games from present law.
- 2. Remove the definition of "scrimmage" from proposed law.
