- 17 assessment shall determine facility placement.
- 18 (2) A medical, educational, and psychological evaluation of each child to 19 be performed upon placement in the custody of the office of juvenile justice.
- 20 (3) A continuum of care plan for each child in the custody of the office 21 of juvenile justice, which, at a minimum, shall include treatment, service, 22 academic, and vocational opportunities."
