Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Education to Reengrossed House Bill No. 315 by Representative Turner

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1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 14, between the period "." and "Public" start a new line and insert "B."

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 2, line 8, before the period "." insert "skills"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 2, line 17, after the period "." delete the remainder of the line, delete lines 18 and  
7 19, and insert the following:

8 "(4) Teach orientation and mobility skills at the earliest possible age to blind, visually  
9 impaired, or deaf-blind students and continuously throughout"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 2, line 21, change "(4) Inform parents" to "(5) Inform the parents or legal  
12 guardians"

13 AMENDMENT NO. 5

14 On page 2, delete lines 27 through 29, on page 3, delete lines 1 through 3, and insert the  
15 following:

16 "(6) Ensure each Individualized Education Program team:  
17 (a) Provides for braille instruction and assistive technologies for students who  
18 qualify for such resources.  
19 (b) Includes a communication plan in the Individualized Education Program  
20 for each student that incorporates the student and his parents or legal guardians.  
21 (c) Includes a communication plan in each Individual Accommodation Plan."

22 AMENDMENT NO. 6

23 On page 3, line 11, after "deaf-blind." delete the remainder of the line, delete lines 12-21,  
24 and insert the following:

25 "(9) Provide students who are blind, visually impaired, or deaf-blind full  
26 access to all programs in their educational settings.  
27 (10) Place students who are blind, visually impaired, or deaf-blind in a  
28 classroom setting that is best suited to each student's individual needs, including but  
29 not limited to social, emotional, and cultural needs, with consideration for the  
30 student's degree and type of vision and hearing loss, academic level, modes of  
31 communication, and learning style.  
32 (11) Provide students who are blind, visually impaired, or deaf-blind with  
33 free, appropriate education across a full spectrum of educational programs and  
34 activities.  
35 (12) Provide students who are blind, visually impaired, or deaf-blind with"

37 On page 3, line 24, after the period "." delete the remainder of the line, on line 25 delete  
38 "funded programs shall treat such" and insert the following:

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"(13) Treat blind, visually impaired, or deaf-blind"
