SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH: Recognizes June 27, 2022, as Post-Traumatic Stress Injury Awareness Day

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2	To recognize Monday, June 27, 2022, as Post-Traumatic Stress Injury Awareness Day in
3	Louisiana.
4	WHEREAS, everyone has a right to the preservation of personal dignity; and
5	WHEREAS, all citizens of the United States deserve the investment of resources to
6	ensure their lasting physical, mental, and emotional well-being; and
7	WHEREAS, the diagnosis known as post-traumatic stress disorder was first defined
8	by the American Psychiatric Association in 1980 in order to more accurately understand and
9	treat veterans who endured severe, traumatic combat stress; and
10	WHEREAS, combat stress has historically been viewed incorrectly as a mental
11	illness caused by a pre-existing flaw of character or ability, and the word disorder carries a
12	stigma that perpetuates this misconception; and
13	WHEREAS, referring to complications from post-traumatic stress as a disorder
14	perpetuates the stigma of and bias against mental illness, and this stigma can discourage the
15	injured from seeking proper and timely medical treatment; and
16	WHEREAS, through the use of electro-magnetic imaging, the medical field has
17	demonstrated that the condition of post-traumatic stress is more accurately described as an
18	injury; and
19	WHEREAS, post-traumatic stress injury (PTSI) is a common injury to the brain that
20	is treatable and repairable; and

1 WHEREAS, PTSI can occur as a result of severely traumatic events, including 2 interpersonal violence, combat, life-threatening accidents, and combat disasters; and 3 WHEREAS, destigmatizing PTSI and honoring the bravery of persons recovering 4 from this injury can favorably influence those affected and encourage them to seek help 5 without fear of retribution or shame; and 6 WHEREAS, all citizens suffering from PTSI deserve our compassion and consideration, and those who have received their wounds in action against an enemy of the 7 8 United States further deserve our tribute and recognition; and 9 WHEREAS, proper and timely treatment can improve health outcomes and diminish 10 rates of suicide among people with PTSI. 11 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby 12 recognize Monday, June 27, 2022, as Post-Traumatic Stress Injury Awareness Day in 13 Louisiana. 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the legislature does hereby urge the Louisiana 15 Department of Health and Department of Veterans Affairs to increase efforts to educate 16 survivors of interpersonal violence, combat, life-threatening accidents, and natural disasters, 17 veterans and their families, and the general public about the causes, symptoms, and 18 treatments of post-traumatic stress injury. 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the 20 governor of Louisiana, the secretary of the Department of Health, and the secretary of the Department of Veterans Affairs. 21
