| 7  | WHEREAS, the Lafayette Parish School System finished first overall in the Louisiana            |
| 8  | Governor's Games 25th annual elementary state championship fitness meet scoring 2,422 total    |
| 9  | points to top the competition; the Caddo Parish School System finished in second place with    |
| 10 | 2,338 points, and the Evangeline Parish School System finished in third place with 2,296       |
| 11 | points; and  |
| 12 | WHEREAS, the elementary fitness competition consists of seven fitness-related                  |
| 13 | events; these events are the 50-yard dash, shuttle run, pull-ups, standing long-jump, curl-ups |
| 14 | or sit ups, 600-yard run, and V-sit and reach; and   |
| 15 | WHEREAS, the top-two boys and girls from each parish travel to Baton Rouge                     |
| 16 | annually to compete for the Louisiana elementary fitness title; Lafayette's top performer, Eli |
| 17 | Bonnie, led the way with 652 individual points; his teammates, Landon Moran, Emma Claire       |
| 18 | Hargrave, and Addison Arnaud, anchored their parish to victory; and                            |
| 19 | WHEREAS, the elementary fitness meet has served as the Olympic Games for                       |
| 20 | elementary school-aged children in thirty parishes across Louisiana since 1997 with more than  |

- 1 two hundred thousand Louisiana elementary students competing for the state fitness crown;

- WHEREAS, the students and faculty of the Lafayette Parish School System are most
- 4 deserving of the highest recognition for their incredible achievement in winning the Louisiana
- 5 Governor's Games 25th annual elementary state championship fitness meet.
