**Crews**

**SCHOOLS: Provides relative to treatment of students with seizure disorders and training of school employees**

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DIGEST

Proposed law authorizes a parent or guardian and physician to develop a seizure management treatment plan for a child with a seizure disorder and submit such plan to the administration of the student's school.

Proposed law requires the state Dept. of Education to approve and provide courses regarding treating students with seizure disorders that include information about seizure recognition and related first aid. Requires two such courses, one each for:

- (1) School nurses.
- (2) Other school employees who have regular interactions with students with seizure management and treatment plans.

Proposed law requires local public school governing authorities to require employees to complete such courses biennially.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Education to the engrossed bill

1. Removes online mandate of courses.
2. Requires courses to be completed biennially.
