HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES: Creates a special study committee to study school safety issues

A RESOLUTION

2	To create a special study committee of the House of Representatives to study school safety
3	issues and report findings and conclusions, including any recommendations for
4	legislation, to the House of Representatives not later than February 1, 2023.
5	WHEREAS, the Louisiana House of Representatives recognizes and acknowledges
6	that school safety is of the highest importance; and
7	WHEREAS, current law, R.S. 17:416.16, provides relative to school crisis
8	management and response plans, including requirements relative to their preparation,
9	content, review, revision, and rehearsal; and
10	WHEREAS, current law, R.S. 17:416.19, authorizes schools to enter into agreements
11	with local law enforcement agencies to provide for school resource officers; and
12	WHEREAS, in light of recent incidents of school violence, it is important that further
13	discussions be held relative to school safety.
14	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
15	Legislature of Louisiana does hereby create a special study committee of the House of
16	Representatives to study school safety issues and report findings and conclusions, including
17	any recommendations for legislation, to the House of Representatives not later than
18	February 1, 2023.
