BOATS/SHIPS/VESSELS: Authorizes the use of personal watercraft between sunrise and sunset

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 34:855.3(C), relative to the regulation of personal watercraft; to
3	provide an exception to the prohibition against the use of personal watercraft at
4	night; and to provide for relative matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 34:855.3(C) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§855.3. Regulation of personal watercraft
8	* * *
9	C. A person shall not operate a personal watercraft at any time between
10	sunset and sunrise unless equipped with navigational lights in accordance with the
11	regulations of the United States Coast Guard.

Abstract: Authorizes the use of personal watercraft between sunrise and sunset when properly equipped with navigation lights.

Present law prohibits the operation of a watercraft at any time between sunset and sunrise.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds an exception that allows the use of personal watercraft for night navigation with properly approved navigation lights.

(Amends R.S. 34:855.3(C))
