Abstract: Requires public school governing authorities to establish carpool and bus line safety policies.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the general powers and duties of local public school boards.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires each public school governing authority to establish a safety policy for carpool and bus lines at schools with grades kindergarten through five.

At a minimum, the policy shall:

- (1) Require students to remain behind a barrier before entering a pick up area.
- (2) Prohibit students from entering the pick up area until the vehicle is in park.
- (3) Require school employees working in the pick up area to wear traffic vests.
- (4) Require that students under the age of 10 be accompanied by a school employee while walking to and from a vehicle.
