D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty five dollars
that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of administrative costs.
E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded to the treasurer of the SWLA Juneteenth Committee. The monies received from the royalty fees shall be used to assist the SWLA Juneteenth Committee.
F. The secretary shall promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are necessary to implement the provisions of this Section.

Section 2. The Department of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles, is hereby directed to create the special prestige license plate when the applicable statutory provisions are met and its system is updated to accommodate the creation of the new plates.

#### Abstract

Creates the "Juneteenth" special prestige license plate. Provides for the creation, issuance, design, implementation, fees, distribution, and promulgation of rules applicable to this license plate.

Proposed law requires the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to issue a special prestige license plate to be known as the "Juneteenth" license plate, provided there is a minimum of 1,000 applicants for such a plate.

Proposed law requires that the secretary work in conjunction with the Southwest La. (SWLA) Juneteenth Committee to select the color and design of the plate. Requires the design include the word "Juneteenth".

Proposed law specifies that the license plates will be issued, upon application, to any citizen of La. in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

Proposed law requires the department to collect an annual royalty fee of $\$ 25$ in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax and a $\$ 3.50$ handling fee for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of administrative costs.


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Proposed law requires monies received from the royalty fees to be forwarded to the treasurer of the SWLA Juneteenth Committee. Specifies that the monies received from the royalty fees be used to assist the SWLA Juneteenth Committee.

Proposed law requires the secretary to promulgate and adopt rules and regulations to implement the provisions provided in proposed law.

Directs the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles, to create the "Juneteenth" speciality license plate when the applicable statutory provisions are met and its system is updated to accommodate the creation of new plates.
