Abstract: Removes certain employment eligibility requirements for certain unclassified state employees relative to the registration of motor vehicles.

<u>Present law</u> provides that any person employed in an unclassified position as defined by the State Civil Service Commission with an annual salary of \$100,000 or more shall provide proof to his public employer that he has been issued a La. driver's license and that all vehicles registered in his name are registered in La. Further provides that any person employed in an unclassified position who does not meet the requirements shall be removed and terminated.

Proposed law repeals present law.
