11	servant; he is also remembered by his close friends and family as an extremely kind and
12	honest man with a passion for aviation; and
13	WHEREAS, Sergeant David J. Poirrier sacrificed his life protecting his community;
14	he was preceded in death by his mother, Deborah, and he leaves to cherish his memory his
15	daughter, Jaci; brothers, Daniel and Derek; and his father, David; he will be deeply missed,
16	but his legacy will live on forever in the hearts and minds of all who knew and loved him.
