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Abstract: Permits the Louisiana Department of Health (LDH) to revoke or deny renewal of a license to a nursing home that has failed to correct a rejected emergency preparedness plan.

<u>Present law</u> requires nursing homes to submit an emergency preparedness plan to LDH for approval. If LDH rejects the plan, it sends a rejection letter and provides an opportunity for the nursing home to amend the plan. LDH must not issue or renew a license of a nursing home that has received a letter of rejection.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes <u>present law</u> by allowing LDH to exercise discretion to revoke or deny renewal of a license to a nursing home if the nursing home fails to incorporate required changes into an emergency preparedness plan that was previously rejected by LDH.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

- 1. Make technical corrections.
- 2. Repeal <u>present law</u> that provides that LDH shall not issue a license to or renew a license of a nursing home that has received a letter of rejection of its emergency preparedness plan.
