### 39 **20-950 JUDGMENTS**

40 Notwithstanding the provisions of R.S. 49:112, the sum of \$12,500,000 or so much 41 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the State General Fund (Direct) 42 for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 to be allocated to pay consent judgments and other final 43 judgments against the state, Board of Tax Appeals judgments and recommendations for 44 payment of a claim against the state, and reimbursements of attorney fees, all as provided 45 in this Section. A judgment or recommendation may only be paid from this appropriation

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1 if it is final. All judgments and recommendations provided for in this Section shall be paid 2 as to principal, interest, court costs, and expert witness fees as awarded in each judgment or 3 recommendation, it being the intent herein that when the provisions of a judgment or 4 recommendation conflict with the provisions of this Act, the provisions of the judgment or 5 recommendation shall be controlling. Any other provision of this Act not in conflict with 6 the provisions of a judgment or recommendation shall control. Payment shall be made as 7 to each judgement, Board of Tax Appeals judgment or recommendation, or reimbursement 8 for attorney fees only after presentation to the state treasurer of documentation required by 9 the state treasurer. Further, all judgments and recommendations provided for in this Section 10 shall be deemed to have been paid on the effective date of the Act, and interest shall cease 11 to run as of that date.
