## 11(b) No advertising or sponsorship signs may be placed pursuant to this12Paragraph until the secretary promulgates rules and regulations, in accordance with

- 13 the Administrative Procedure Act, that include, at a minimum, all of the following:
- (i) Specifications regarding types of businesses with which sponsorship
  agreements are authorized and with which sponsorship agreements are prohibited.
- (ii) Specifications regarding the size, types, and placement of advertisements
  and sponsorship signs that will be allowed on or within agency property.
