CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE: Provides relative to expungement of records

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Relocates proposed law to a newly enacted Code of Criminal Procedure Article.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Present law provides for the expungement of certain arrest and conviction records under certain circumstances.

Proposed law retains present law and authorizes the following courts, throughout their several jurisdictions, to expunge records:

- (1) District courts and their commissioners within their trial jurisdiction.
- (2) City or parish courts within their trial jurisdiction.
- (3) Mayor's courts and traffic courts within their trial jurisdiction.
- (4) Juvenile and family courts within their trial jurisdiction.
- (5) Municipal and traffic courts of New Orleans within their trial jurisdiction.
