- 21 patient's outcome and impacts the clinical decision.
- 22 (b) The most appropriate test may include both information that is
- 23 actionable and information that cannot be immediately used in the formulation
- 24 <u>of a clinical decision.</u>"

- 26 On page 3, after line 27, insert the following:
- "Section 2. The provisions of this Act apply to any new policy, contract, program,
- or health coverage plan issued on and after January 1, 2024. Any policy, contract, or health
- coverage plan in effect prior to January 1, 2024, shall convert to conform to the provisions
- of this Act on or before the renewal date, but no later than January 1, 2025."
