1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, line 2, after "To" change "enact R.S. 17:170(A)(4)" to "amend and reenact R.S.
17:170(F) and to enact R.S. 17:170(A)(4) and (G)"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, line 4, after "school;" insert "to provide relative to students registered for courses
that do not meet physically;"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, delete line 7, and insert "Section 1. R.S. 17:170(F) is hereby amended and 9 reenacted and R.S. 17:170(A)(4) and (G) are hereby enacted to read as follows:"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 1, after line 18, and insert:

"F. In the event of an outbreak of a vaccine-preventable disease at the location of an 12 13 educational institution or facility enumerated in Subsection A of this Section, the 14 administrators of that institution or facility are empowered, upon the recommendation of the office of public health, to exclude from attendance unimmunized students and clients any 15 16 student or client for whom it has no record of or insufficient record of immunization until the appropriate disease incubation period has expired or the unimmunized person presents 17 18 evidence of immunization. 19 G. The provisions of Paragraphs (A)(1) through (3) of this Section shall not apply 20 to any person whose course registration is limited to correspondence courses, online courses, 21 or any other courses at a postsecondary education institution that do not require meeting physically on campus for any reason or at any time. If such person subsequently registers 22 23 for courses that meet physically on campus, such person shall be required to provide

24 satisfactory evidence of current immunization as a condition of registration for such courses

25 at such institution as provided in Paragraphs (A)(1) through (3) of the Section."
