Existing law provides that a marshal or constable, except the marshal of the city court of Lake Charles, may be designated for each city court.

<u>New law</u> removes the exception for the city court marshal of Lake Charles.

<u>New law</u> designates the city court marshal of Lake Charles as the ward three marshal and designates the city court marshal of Sulphur as the ward four marshal.

<u>Prior law</u> required a deputy constable to be a resident of the parish within which the elected constable's ward was located.

<u>New law</u> changes the requirement that the deputy constable be a resident of the parish within which the elected constable's ward is located and requires the deputy constable to be a resident of this state.

Effective August 1, 2023.
