Existing law provides for the offense of intentional littering and establishes criminal penalties that may be imposed upon conviction of the offense.

<u>Existing law</u> further provides for the offense of simple littering and establishes civil penalties which may be imposed upon a person being found liable for the offense.

<u>Existing law</u> provides that a person committing either offense must be cited by means of a citation, summons, or other lawful method.

<u>New law</u> further provides that the <u>existing law</u> offenses of intentional and simple littering must be cited within one year of when law enforcement knew or reasonably should have known of the violation.

Effective August 1, 2023.
