**Abstract:** Provides for an increase in wireless telephone service charges for 911 emergency services in the Terrebonne Parish Communications District.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the creation of parish communications districts which provide 911 services and which are funded by service charges on telephone service.

<u>Present law</u> provides that a governing authority of any communications district may levy a commercial mobile radio service (CMRS) telephone service charge not to exceed \$1.25/month per wireless CMRS connection.

<u>Proposed law provides</u> for an exception; authorizes the governing authority of the Terrebonne Parish Communications District to levy a CMRS telephone service charge at a rate of not more than \$1.85/month per wireless CMRS connection.
