RETIREMENT/CLERKS COURT: Provides relative to benefits of the Clerks' of Court Retirement and Relief Fund

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 11:1503(9) and 1524(A)(1), relative to the Clerks' of Court	
3	Retirement and Relief Fund; to provide relative to survivors; to provide for optional	
4	survivor benefit payments; and to provide for related matters.

If the retiree dies before he has received, in annuity 9 payments purchased by his contributions, the amount of his contributions 10 accumulated at the time of his retirement, the balance thereof shall be paid to any 11 person he shall have nominated by written designation, duly acknowledged and filed 12 with the board of trustees at the time of his retirement, or, if none, to his estate; or 13

Abstract: Provides relative to survivors and benefit payments to surviving beneficiaries in the Clerks' of Court Retirement and Relief Fund (Clerks').

<u>Present law</u> provides definitions applicable to the Clerks' retirement system. Provides that "surviving spouse" means the spouse of a deceased member or former member who was married to and living with the deceased member or former member at the time of his death.

<u>Proposed law</u> removes the stipulation that the surviving spouse was *living with* the deceased member or former member. Otherwise retains <u>present law</u>.

<u>Present law</u> provides a retiree with several options for the payment of benefits upon his death. One option is: if the retiree dies before he has received the amount of his contributions at the time of his retirement, the balance is paid to any person he designates or to his estate if there is not a designee.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> except that all of the deceased retiree's contributions are paid to the designee or to the estate rather than only those accumulated at the time of retirement.
