Abstract: Increases qualifying fees for candidates of certain state offices.

Present law establishes qualifying fees for candidates of certain state offices.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases qualifying fees for candidates for governor <u>from</u> \$750 to \$5,000.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases qualifying fees for candidates for lieutenant governor, secretary of state, attorney general, treasurer, commissioner of agriculture, and commissioner of insurance <u>from</u> \$600 to \$5,000.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases qualifying fees for candidates for U.S. senator and representative in congress from \$600 to \$2,500.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases qualifying fees for candidates for public service commission $\underline{\text{from}}$ \$450 $\underline{\text{to}}$ \$2,500.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> providing that the qualifying fee for candidates for justice of the supreme court or appeals court judge is \$450 and that the qualifying fee for other state candidates is \$600.
