INSURANCE: Provides relative to examinations and certain adopted handbooks

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 22:1981(D), relative to examinations; to modify relative to  
3 guidelines used for examinations authorized by the commissioner of insurance; and  
4 to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 22:1981(D) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

7 §1981. Commissioner of insurance to examine insurers and producers

8 \* \* \*

9 D. Upon determining that an examination should be conducted, the  
10 commissioner shall appoint one or more examiners to perform the examination and  
11 instruct them as to the scope of the examination. In conducting the examination, the  
12 examiner or examiners shall observe those guidelines and procedures set forth in the  
13 Examiners' Market Regulation Handbook adopted by the National Association of  
14 Insurance Commissioners. The commissioner may also employ such other  
15 guidelines or procedures as the commissioner may deem appropriate.

**Abstract:** Changes the handbook of examiners from the Examiners' Handbook to the Market Regulation Handbook.

Present law provides for examinations of insurers and producers. Requires certain examinations and authorizes the commissioner of insurance (commissioner) to conduct examinations when deemed necessary.

When the commissioner determines the need for examination, present law requires the commissioner to appoint one or more examiners to perform the examination and to them instruct regarding the scope. Requires examiners to observe guidelines and procedures in the Examiners' Handbook adopted by the National Assoc. of Insurance Commissioners. Further authorizes the commissioner to employ other guidelines or procedures deemed appropriate.

Proposed law changes the Examiners' Handbook to the Market Regulation Handbook. Otherwise retains present law.
