3	for salary increases for judges of the supreme court, courts of appeal, district courts,
4	city courts, and parish courts as recommended by the Judicial Compensation

6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 13:50(1) and (2) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as

9	§50. Salary as recommended by the Judicial Compensation Commission
10	Pursuant to the Judicial Compensation Commission's report dated January 9,
11	2018:
12	(1) Subject to the provisions of Paragraph (3) of this Section, the actual
13	salary of the judges of the supreme court, courts of appeal, and district courts shall
14	be increased by two and one-half three percent on July first of 2019, 2020, 2021,
15	<del>2022, and 2023</del> <u>2024, 2025, 2026, 2027, and 2028</u> .
16	(2) Subject to the provisions of Paragraph (3) of this Section, the state-paid
17	actual salary of the judges of city courts and parish courts shall be increased by two
18	and one-half three percent on July first of 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, and 2023 2024,
19	2025, 2026, 2027, and 2028.

**Abstract:** Provides relative to salaries for judges as recommended by the Judicial Compensation Commission.

<u>Present law</u> provides relative to judicial compensation and salaries for the years 2019 through 2023.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the actual salary of the judges of the supreme courts, courts of appeal, and district courts shall be increased by 2.5% on July 1st of 2019 through 2023.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the state-paid salary of city court and parish court judges shall be increased by 2.5% on July 1st of 2019 through 2023.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the actual salary of the judges of the supreme courts, courts of appeal, and district courts shall be increased by 3% on July 1st of 2024 through 2028.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the state-paid salary of city court and parish court judges shall be increased by 3% on July 1st of 2024 through 2028.
