Abstract: Authorizes golf carts to cross La. Hwy. 378 at McKinley St. and John Stine Rd. and La. Hwy. 379 at Hilma St., Gray St., and Railroad Ave. in the city of Westlake.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes golf carts to cross LA 378 at McKinley St. and John Stine Rd. and LA 379 at Hilma St., Gray St., and Railroad Ave. in the city of Westlake between sunrise and sunset.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires a valid driver's license when operating a golf cart while crossing LA 378 and at LA 379.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires crossing signs to be posted by Dept. of Transportation and Development (DOTD) at the request of the governing authority of the city of Westlake.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the DOTD, with the consultation and advice of the governing authority of the city of Westlake, to formulate guidelines to determine where such crossing signs are to be placed.

<u>Proposed law</u> excepts the provisions of <u>proposed law</u> from certain requirements contained in <u>present</u> <u>law</u> and provides that golf carts are not considered a vehicle for purposes of defining "equipment".
