Art. 335. Rule to show cause; bond forfeiture

If the defendant fails to make an appearance and has not been surrendered or constructively surrendered within one hundred eighty days of the execution of the certificate that notice of warrant for arrest was sent, the prosecuting attorney may file a rule to show cause requesting that a bond forfeiture judgment be rendered. The rule to show cause shall be mailed to the defendant and served on all other parties against whom a judgment is sought. The rule to show cause shall be set for a contradictory hearing. The time period for filing a rule to show cause to obtain a judgment of bond forfeiture does not begin until shall be within three hundred sixty days after the notice of warrant for arrest is sent.

**Abstract:** Provides relative to bond forfeiture.

<u>Present law</u> provides that a prosecuting attorney may file a rule to show cause requesting that a bond forfeiture judgment be rendered when a defendant fails to appear in court and has not surrendered within 180 days of an issuance of an arrest warrant.

<u>Present law</u> also provides that the time period to file a rule to show cause begins after the notice of warrant for arrest is sent.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but provides that the time period for filing a rule to show cause shall be within 360 days after the notice of warrant is sent.
