10	B. A physician assistant shall notify the board of any changes in or additions
11	to his supervising physicians within fifteen thirty days of the date of such change or
12	addition.

<u>Present law</u> requires the physician assistant to notify the board of any changes in or additions to his supervising physicians within 15 days of the date of the change.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the time frame to notify the board to 30 days from the date of change.
