Abstract: Changes the allocation of revenues received by the state from license fees imposed on trappers by directing all excess revenue to the Louisiana Fur Public Education and Marketing Fund.

<u>Present law</u> requires all revenues received by the state from license fees imposed on trappers as required in <u>present law</u> (R.S. 56:251(A)(1)) be credited to the Bond Security and Redemption Fund. <u>Present law</u> provides that the state treasurer is authorized and directed to transfer annually excess revenues derived from the sale of such licenses into a special fund designated as the La. Fur Public Education and Marketing Fund, in the amount of \$20 for each resident trapping license sold and \$145 for each nonresident trapping license sold.

<u>Proposed law</u> modifies <u>present law</u> by specifying that the state treasurer is authorized and directed to transfer annually all excess revenues to the La. Fur Public Education and Marketing Fund.
