2	To amend and reenact Section 2 of Act No. 386 of the 2022 Regular Session of the
3	Legislature, as amended by Act No. 322 of the 2021 Regular Session of the
4	Legislature, relative to prescription; to provide relative to the prescriptive period for
5	certain civil actions against a person for certain acts committed against a minor; to
6	provide relative to implementation; to provide for an effective date; and to provide
7	for related matters.
8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. Section 2 of Act No. 386 of the 2022 Regular Session of the Legislature,
10	as amended by Act No. 322 of the 2021 Regular Session of the Legislature, is hereby
11	amended and reenacted to read as follows:
12	* * *
13	Section 2. Any person whose cause of action related to sexual abuse of a minor was
14	barred by liberative prescription shall be permitted to file an action under R.S. 9:2800.9 on
15	or before June 14, <del>2024</del> <u>2027</u> . It is the express intent of the legislature to revive until June
16	14, <del>2024</del> <b>2027</b> , any cause of action related to sexual abuse of a minor that previously

prescribed under any Louisiana prescriptive period.

<u>Present law</u> provides that any person whose cause of action related to sexual abuse of a minor was barred by liberative prescription shall be permitted to file an action under <u>present law</u> on or before June 14, 2024.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that it is the express intent of the legislature to revive until June 14, 2024, any cause of action related to sexual abuse of a minor that previously prescribed under any La. prescriptive period.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>, but extends the deadline to file an action <u>from</u> June 14, 2024 to June 14, 2027.

Effective June 14, 2024.
