Duplessis

<u>Present law</u> defines crime against nature by solicitation as the solicitation by a human being of another with the intent to engage in any unnatural carnal copulation for compensation. <u>Present law</u> further provides that crime against nature by solicitation is punishable on a first conviction by a fine of up to \$500, imprisonment for up to six months, or both. <u>Present law</u> further provides that a second or subsequent conviction is punishable by a fine between \$250 and \$2,000, imprisonment with or without hard labor for up to two years, or both. <u>Present law</u> further provides relative to sex offender registration and defenses to prosecution.

Proposed law repeals present law.

Effective August 1, 2024.
