Duplessis

<u>Present law</u> requires that to the extent funds are available, the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry, in cooperation with public and private sector partners, establish a financing program that provides grants and loans to healthy food retailers that increase access to fresh fruits and vegetables and other affordable healthy food in underserved communities.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but deletes the language "to the extent funds are available".

<u>Present law</u> allows the department to contract with one or more qualified nonprofit organizations or community development financial institutions to administer the program through a public-private partnership, to raise matching funds, market the program statewide, evaluate applicants, make award decisions, underwrite loans, and monitor compliance and impact.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the department must contract with qualified nonprofit organizations or community development financial institutions.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the program must provide funding on a competitive, one-time basis for eligible projects.

<u>Proposed law</u> deletes the language "one-time basis", and requires the program to provide funding on a competitive basis.
