Section 1. R.S. 32:386(K) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

K. Vehicles and combinations of vehicles shall be loaded in such manner that the axle limitations set forth in Subsections C, D, E, F, and G of this Section are not exceeded. However, while operating on any state-maintained highway except the Interstate System, the provisions of Subsections C, D, E, F, and G of this Section shall not be deemed to have been violated **and not be penalized** unless the axle weight exceeds by more than two thousand pounds Subsections C and F of this Section or more than three thousand pounds Subsections D, E, and G of this Section. This Subsection shall in no way be construed to allow the total gross weight in any vehicle or combination of vehicles to exceed the gross weight limits set forth in Subsection A or I of this Section.

 $\underline{\text{Proposed law}}$  retains  $\underline{\text{present law}}$  and provides no penalty should be issued unless axle weight exceed two thousand pounds.
