EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Annual Total

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. The Department of Wildlife and Fisheries (LDWF) is able to make the proposed changes to the licensing system using existing resources and staff.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

Proposed law would result in no overall impact to statutory dedications revenue for LDWF as this legislation would solely change the destination where revenue from waterfowl hunting licenses is deposited. Collections from these licenses in FY 23 were a total of \$804,162; of that total, \$375,742 was deposited into the Conservation Fund, while \$428,420 was deposited into the Louisiana Duck License, Stamp, and Print Fund. Proposed law will result in all revenue deposited into the Louisiana Duck License, Stamp, and Print Fund and none into the Conservation Fund. This amount of revenue can be expected as long as sales of licenses remain at a similar level.
