Makes revisions to the system of laws providing for elections

Proposed law makes various revisions to the Louisiana Election Code (Title 18)

Proposed law extends the penalty for failure to file to political action committees that fail to file or timely file the required statement of organization. The penalty is \$100 per day, not to exceed \$2,500, for political committees designated as the principal campaign committee or subsidiary committee for a candidate for major office; \$60 per day, not to exceed \$2,000, for political committees designated as the principal campaign committee or subsidiary committee for a candidate of a district office; \$40 per day, not to exceed \$1,000, for political committees supporting or opposing a candidate for all other offices, propositions or questions submitted to the voters, or any recall of a public officer; and, \$200 per day, not to exceed \$3,000, for a political committee supporting or opposing a candidate but is not the principal or subsidiary campaign committee.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. Proposed law provides for various technical and clarifying changes for the Department of State and extends the penalty for failure to file to political action committees who fail to file or timely file the required statement of organization.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

Proposed law may result in an increase in SGF revenues as a result of extending the civil penalty for failure to file to political action committees that fail to file or timely file the required statement of organization. The Board of Ethics may impose fines for failure to file or timely file the required statement of organization but the agency is unable to predict the amount of fines that may be imposed, thus any increase in revenue is indeterminable.

NOTE: Penalties and fines imposed for the violation of these provisions are considered income not available to the Ethics Administration; thereby, accrue to the State General Fund.
