SENATE BILL NO. 45

ROADS/HIGHWAYS. Designates portions of certain highways. (8/1/24)

1 AN ACT

2 To provide relative to state highways; to designate an elevated portion of Interstate 12 in St.
3 Tammany Parish as the "Patricia 'Pat' Brister Memorial Bridge"; to designate a
4 portion of United States Highway 51 in St. John the Baptist Parish as the "Arnold J.
5 Labat Memorial Highway"; to provide for restrictions on costs of materials to the
6 department; and to provide for related matters.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 **Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,**
9 **the elevated portion of Interstate 12 in St. Tammany Parish, which crosses the**
10 **Tchefuncte River, is hereby designated as the "Patricia 'Pat' Brister Memorial**
11 **Bridge".**

12 **Section 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,**
13 **a portion of United States Highway 51 in St. John the Baptist Parish between**
14 **United States Highway 61 and Interstate 10, is hereby designated as the**
15 **"Arnold J. Labat Memorial Highway".**

16 **Section 3. The Department of Transportation and Development is hereby**
17 **directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs of the designation provided**

- 1 local or private monies are received by the department equal to the
2 department's actual costs for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and
3 installation of each sign, not to exceed the sum of one thousand six hundred
4 eighty dollars per sign.
