Current law levies no inheritance tax, and does not include the value of property acquired by inheritance in taxable income. Previous law levying an inheritance tax was repealed in 2008.

Proposed law removes multiple references to the repealed inheritance tax from the Revised Statutes.

Effective upon governor's signature.
