Subject: Database for student instructional requirements

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EDUCATION OR NO IMPACT See Note Provides relative to student instruction requirements

Proposed legislation requires the Louisiana Department of Education (LDOE) to establish and maintain a database of student instruction required by law that is not provided for in the state content standards adopted by the Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) or the Carnegie units established by LDOE in accordance with BESE policy. Specifies the content of the database and requires a report to the House and Senate education committees every five years. Provides that no requirement that increases the instructional burden on professional teachers related to content, topics, or methods that are not provided for in the state content standards adopted by BESE or the Carnegie units established by LDOE is to be effective, and that any requirement for additional instructional content will become effective only if first approved by BESE, or if the burden of the requirement is offset by the elimination of another instructional requirement with an equivalent burden on professional teachers.
