Substitute for Original House Bill No. 490 by Representative Bayham as proposed by the House Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works

To enact R.S. 32:43(A)(3), relative to penalties by unmanned automated speed enforcement

devices in school zones; to prohibit speeding violations from being issued via

unmanned automated speed enforcement devices under certain circumstances; and

to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 32:43(A)(3) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§43. Automated speed enforcement devices; prohibition

A.

* * *

(3) An unmanned automated speed enforcement device shall not be used to issue speeding violations in a school zone when a driver is not exceeding the posted speed limit immediately prior to the school zone if speed limit signs are not posted at the entrance and exit of the school zone.

Abstract: Prohibits speeding violations from being issued via unmanned automated speed enforcement devices under certain circumstances.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits authorities from installing automated speed enforcement devices on interstate roadways within their territorial limits.

Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Present law</u> provides an exception to <u>present law</u> for Dept. of Transportation construction zones except for local municipal authorities and local parish authorities.

Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds a prohibition for imposition of speeding violations within a school zone via unmanned automated speed enforcement devices when the driver is not exceeding the posted speed limit immediately prior to the school zone if speed limit signs are not posted at the entrance and exit of the school zone.
